Thank you for your interest in Areteem Institute.

We are currently accepting enrollment for school year 2018 – 2019.

Please follow these simple steps to begin the application process:

1. Submit Candidate Profile and Application Fee. Candidate Profile form is attached. Application Fee is \$40 for US based students and \$60 for international students. Kindly process application fee with cashier's check or go to our website at <http://areteem.org> to pay by credit card.

2. Submit a Student Essay. The composition can be about any subject matter that interests the student, maximum of 500 words. We encourage you to show us your creativity!
3. Submit a Parent Statement. A parent statement is an effective communication tool for us to understand the student better, learn more about the applicant and know what the parents expect from our school, so we can better help the students achieve their goals. Please complete the attached Parent Statement form.
4. Submit your most recent School Report Card with the Official Transcript. Request for Transcript form is attached.
5. For applicant grades 6, 7, and 8, kindly complete our Areteem Institute Individual Assessment Test for Middle School students. For applicant grades 9, 10 and 11, kindly complete our Areteem Institute Individual Assessment Test for High School students. You may request for these assessment tests by sending us an email at info@areteem.org.
6. Provide the Required Standardized Tests. For applicant grades 9, 10 and 11, the SSAT exam is preferred. The ISEE may also be submitted in place of the SSAT. Applicants to the 11th grade may submit the PSAT or SAT. For more information on testing dates and locations, visit www.ssat.org, www.erbtest.org and www.collegeboard.org. For applicants to grade 12, you may submit the PSAT, SAT or ACT test. For more information on these tests, please visit www.collegeboard.org. International students whose English is not the primary language, please submit the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL). For more information, please visit www.eft.org/toefl.
7. Two Teacher Recommendation letters. Please use the attached form.
8. Schedule an Online Interview. We like to know more about our applicants and be able to meet them face to face. As we are an online college preparatory school, it is just fitting that we conduct our applicant interviews through our Online platform. Kindly email us at info@areteem.org to schedule an interview.
9. Financial Aid assistance. Areteem Institute provides financial based scholarship to qualified students. To apply, kindly submit your most recent Income Tax Return and W2 forms.
